Hi

I started responding yesterday and found just before i posted it, that something has changed on Google Base, so i didn't post the info until i knew all the info. It appears that many people from about the 1st of march have started having issues with Google Base, with feeds being declined that were OK before, and other issues such as characters that were being allowed before, now being rejected. I have a consultant who specialises in Google base looking at this feed at the moment, to see if it is a fault of the feed, or the way Google accepts it.

You have to remember though, that Google Base is still in a beta form, and also free, whihc means there is very little i can do to push it along accept hope it starts working again.

There are a few emails and questions asking about why feeds arnt showing all their products, i think it may be usually because the feed has duplicate item IDs because the user has added the same product to more than one category. This is then causing Google to think that the feed is sending duplicated info up and declining the feed.

The issue with German Characters is because they are special characters, so they need to be converted into a format that the XML will accept, which is what the feed should be doing anyway. The problem is Google must not be accepting them still, or somethign has changed, as i know i could upload greek characters before and so can other clients.

This explains that Google doesn't like simple encoded special characters, and the way we got around it with the most common character is simple filtering them out to remove them completely.

I am looking into a solution for this, but haven't replied yet, as i have no new info to give over.

I'll keep you informed.

Hi Everybody, can you all please upgrade to the latest version 4.3
<http://www.virtuemartfrooglefeed.com/docman/upgrades/index.php>
which allows changes the feed from using the detailed description, to the short description. As long as there are no special characters in the short description, you should have no issues.

99% of the issues shown in this thread, was HTML tags being brought through from the description, usually where people have copy and pasted content from a manufacturers website. The short description, doesn't allows any formatting, so it works.

Also for you none English people, I'm not sure if this will help, i think it should do.

Let me know, as i will then have to do go to plan B (which isn't planned yet :))

Robusta Im not sure what advice i can give you, the reason for the feed failing on most people is not because the feed is wrong, but because people have added things that causes HTML tagging to occure. Just for SEO reasons really you should have the short description in anyway, as this will help with keywords in the search results.

I havent got around to changing the main file yet with the updated file i released yesterday, i just ran out of time :(

If you generated a feed before updating it, you will need to genertae another feed again to over write the last one with the new feed.

If you see this code at the top of your page whe it is creating the feed

That means the XML file itself is set to have no write permission so it cant overwrite the last feed with the new one, you need to change it to 777 (read and write everybody), and it will work perfect.

If you open the XML file in IE7, it shows

then if you right click on the page and click view source, copy and paste it into Notepad2 and goto line 1396, you will see this

Which is coming from

Which means it is picking info up from the detailed description, not the short description. Unless you have detailed description in the short description as well, which i haven't checked.

The reason it is failing is because it is picking up the ' as a special character and failing it. You need to upgrade to the next version which is 4.3 and run it again, you will probably find it works fine.

That's the one product i was referring to in the previous post, and can see the price (i coloured blue) it says on there
129.00

All the content you have on the short description (I coloured red), is what the Froogle feed is drawing in, as it takes the info from the table in Products "product_s_desc " field of the database as below.

There is no other way for me to do this.

So its not really picking up the price from the price part of the database, it is more like picking it up from the content you have added into the short description.

Also off the subject of my feed, the content that is added to the small content in your database has html (which is fine except not for my feed), but actually its not added properly, as the html ends with

which means the page is finished, but its not, thats just the end of the short description.

And there are 9 cases of which means one for each of the 8 products, and one for the template its self.

Just a pointer as it wont be doing you any favours in SEO.

He had an "&" charactor in the middle of a Product Title, which he changed to "and" and it worked :)

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
