At the moment the Mambot wont work with Joomla 1.5, i dont think it is a huge issue to change over, just a few bits, even if it means to get it working in Legacy mode would do for the moment.

The main problem is that VM1.1 isnt in a stable release yet, but is hopefully targeted for 23rd of April 08.
